This year, the celebrant will offer Mass for those undergoing health treatment. A donation for each intention would be greatly appreciated.

Archbishop Rodi has designated Sunday, May 20, as the official celebration of Mary's Day. The celebration at the Cathedral will take place at 10:00 AM. preceding the 10:30 AM Mass.
