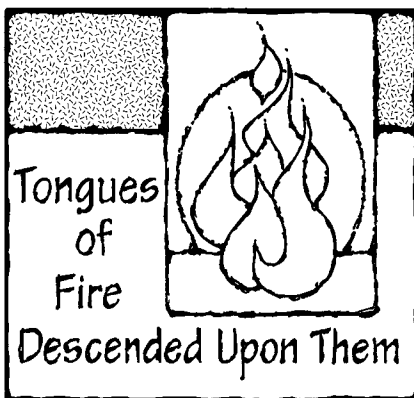
SCRIPTURE THEME:
