

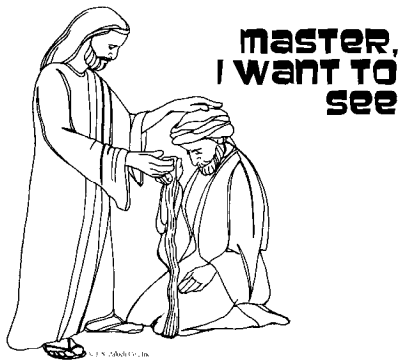
Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time— October 28, 2012
