### **CHRIST THE KING CELEBRATION:**

The annual Archdiocesan celebration of the Feast of Christ the King will be held on Sunday, November 25, 2012, beginning at 10:30 AM in Bienville Square in downtown Mobile. Following the opening prayer, all may join in the Christ the King Procession, where members will recite the Holy Rosary while processing west on Dauphin Street to Cathedral Square. Upon conclusion of the Rosary, Mass will begin at 11:00 a.m. at the Cathedral Basilica of the Immaculate Conception. During Mass, Archbishop Rodi will confer the annual Christ the King Medal to a member from each parish in recognition of their exemplary service to the parish community. Special invitation have been issued to various Catholic organizations within the Archdiocese, however, everyone is invited to participate in this marvelous celebration and witness to our faith and heritage.
