Frequently Asked Questions:

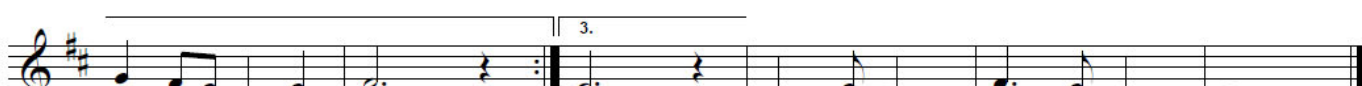
