Frequently Asked Questions:

What is the mural over the organ? That is the "Jesse Tree," depicting the family tree of the Blessed Mother. Our Lady stands in the center of the painting and is surrounded by thirteen smaller figures. These are the Kings of Judah. Immediately below our Lady is David, the son of Jesse. On either side are David's descendents.

Who is buried on the Portico?

That is Bishop John Quinlan, our second bishop. He inherited a cathedral that had not been completed. The cathedral was consecrated on December 8, 1850, but the exterior remained unfinished. Bishop Quinlan continued the work and the portico was completed in his lifetime. When he was dying, he requested to be buried beneath his portico. The "unofficial" story is that he said that he wanted to be buried under the portico because everybody walked over him in life, so they might as well walk over him in death.

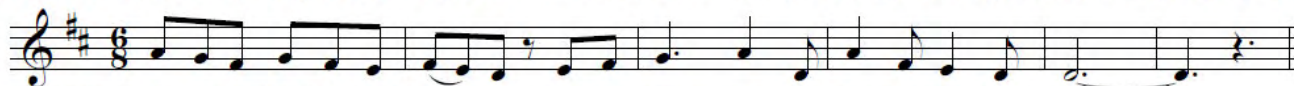

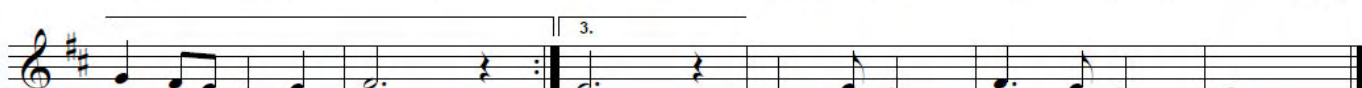
