Frequently Asked Questions:

Why do we pray the Stations of the Cross? The Stations of the Cross are a 14-step Catholic devotion that commemorates Jesus Christ's last day on Earth as a man. The 14 devotions, or stations, focus on specific events of His last day, beginning with His condemnation. The stations are commonly used as a mini pilgrimage as the individual moves from station to station. At each station, the individual recalls and meditates on a specific event from Christ's last day. Specific prayers are recited, then the individual moves to the next station until all 14 are complete. They are commonly prayed on Wednesdays or Fridays in Lent and on Good Friday.

Votive Candles:

We are trying something new with the votive candles in the church. In order to make the candles available when the sacristan is not in the church, we have placed candles on the railing in front of the St. Joseph altar. They are \$3 each. There are envelopes next to the candles. The money can be placed in the collection box next to the column.

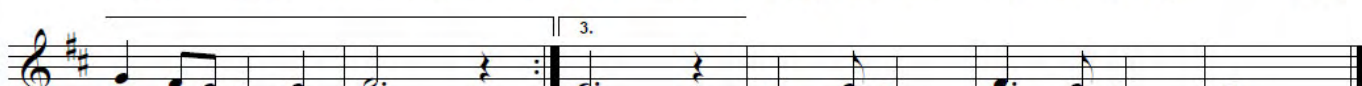
