Frequently Asked Questions:

What are the symbols on the floor of the center aisle of the church? Those are the crests of the bishops. The first three bishops used the same crest, but after that, each has his own.

What is down the spiral stairs? That is the crypt where the bishops are buried. It is a chapel as well. Bishops Portier, Manucy, O'Sullivan, Allen, and Toolen are buried there. Bishop Quinlan is buried on the portico and Bishop May is buried in St. Louis. Visitors are encouraged to go down and see it.

Votive Candles:

We are trying something new with the votive candles in the church. In order to make the candles available when the sacristan is not in the church, we have placed candles on the railing in front of the St. Joseph altar. They are \$3 each. There are envelopes next to the candles. The money can be placed in the collection box next to the column.

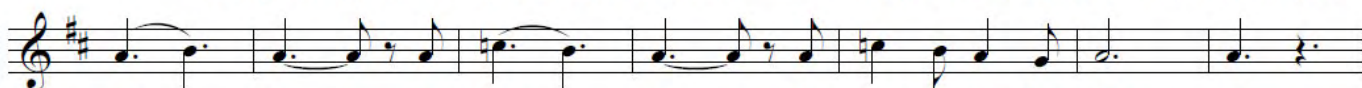
Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father,

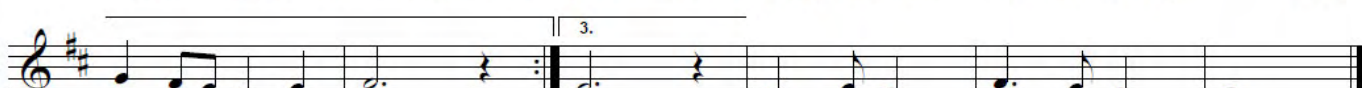
