Frequently Asked Questions:

When does Lent officially end? Lent ends at the beginning of the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday. This marks the start of the Holy Triduum, a liturgical season in its own right.

What is the Holy Triduum? Beginning with Holy Thursday and ending with the evening of Easter Sunday, the Holy Triduum consists of The Mass of the Lord's Supper, Good Friday of the Lord's Passion, and the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord.

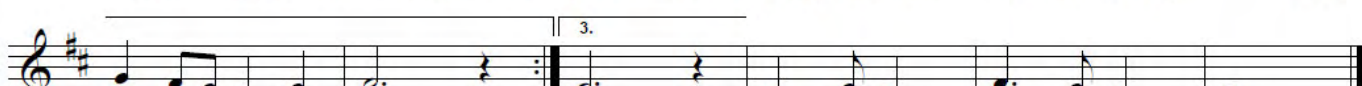
