Frequently Asked Questions:

When will the stained glass windows be returned to the Cathedral?

Three of the windows have been taken for repair to New Berlin, Wisconsin and should be reinstalled within the next several weeks. The windows, a project of Mobile's fifth bishop, Edward P. Allen, were part of Bishop Portier's vision for a Cathedral that is "almost worthy of God."

What hours are the Cathedral open for visitors? The church is open from 8:30-4:30 Monday through Saturday. The church opens at 7:30 on Sunday morning and closes after 10:30 Mass, usually around 12.

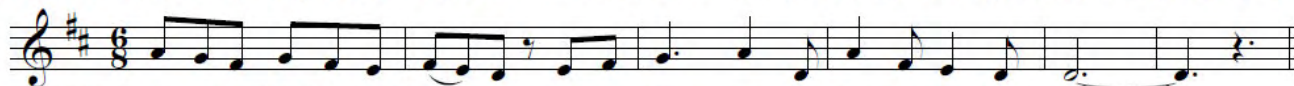

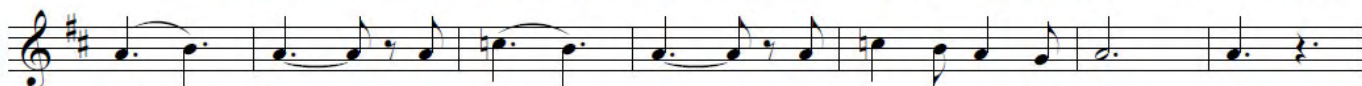
Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father,

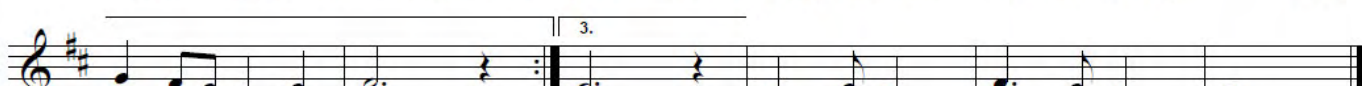
