**Frequently Asked Questions:**

What are the sins against Hope? According to the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, "The first commandment is also concerned with sins against hope, namely, despair and presumption: By *despair*, man ceases to hope for his personal salvation from God, for help in attaining it or for the forgiveness of his sins.

Despair is contrary to God's goodness, to his justice—for the Lord is faithful to his promises and to his mercy. There are two kinds of *presumption*. Either man presumes upon his own capacities, (hoping to be able to save himself without help from on high), or he presumes upon God's almighty power or his mercy (hoping to obtain his forgiveness without conversion and glory without merit). 2091 and 2092

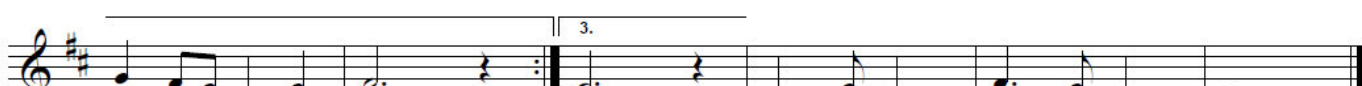
