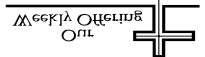
Frequently Asked Questions:

Why do we sing at Mass?

Why We Sing. God has bestowed on his people the gift of song; music is a way for God to lead us to the realm of higher things. As related in Scripture, our ancestors - Moses, David, St. Paul, and St. James, for example - reveled in this gift. Since song has both an individual and a communal dimension, singing together in church expresses the sacramental presence of God to his people. The common, sung expression of faith strengthens our faith when it grows weak and makes the liturgical prayers of the Christian community more alive and fervent. The primordial song of the Liturgy is the canticle of victory over sin and death, and the Paschal hymn continues even after a liturgical celebration ends. Christ leads us on to charity, justice, and evangelization as, particularly inspired by sung participation, the body of the Word Incarnate goes forth to spread the Gospel. 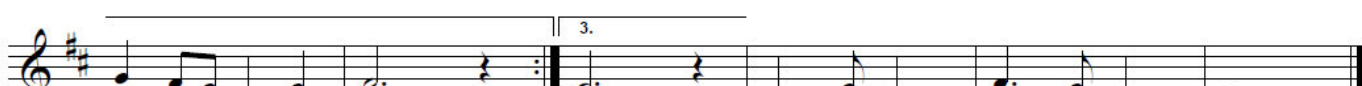
