Frequently Asked Questions:

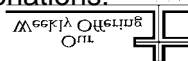
Continuing our topic of music in the Mass, we look at the question, "Why should I participate in the singing?" Holy Mother Church clearly affirms the role within worship of the entire liturgical assembly; the full and active participation by all the people is the aim to be considered before all else, for it is the primary and indispensable source from which the faithful are to derive the true Christian spirit. Participation must be internal, in the sense that by it the faithful join their mind to what they pronounce or hear, uniting themselves interiorly to what the ministers or choir sing. Participation must also be external so that the internal participation can be expressed and reinforced by actions, gestures, and bodily attitude, and by the acclamations, responses, and singing. The quality of our participation comes less from our vocal ability than from the desire of our hearts to sing together of our love for God. Our participation in the Liturgy is challenging, but Christ always invites us to enter into song and give our entire selves to the hymn of the Paschal Sacrifice for the honor and glory of the Most Blessed Trinity. 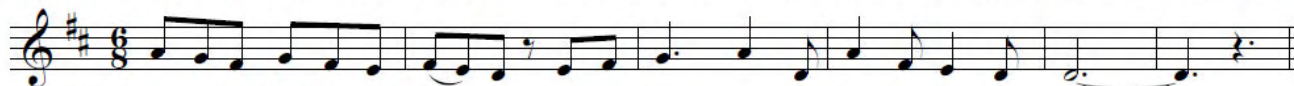

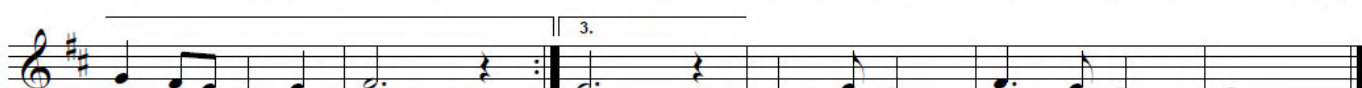
