**Frequently Asked Questions:**

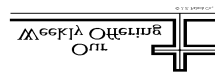
Another installment in our topic of music in the Mass: **The Church at Prayer: The Gathered Liturgical Assembly.** In the celebration of mass the faithful form a holy people, a people whom God has made his own, a royal priesthood, so that they may give thanks to God and offer the spotless Victim not only through the hands of the priest but also together with him, and so that they may learn to offer themselves. This is the basis for the "full, conscious, and active participation" of the faithful demanded by the very nature of the Liturgy; singing is one of the primary ways that the assembly participates actively. Because the gathered assembly is one body, its members must shun any appearance of individualism or division. To foster full, conscious, and active participation, the musical formation of the assembly must be a continuing concern, and music must be within its members' capability. Familiarity with a stable repertoire of liturgical songs rich in theological content can deepen the faith of the community through repetition and memorization. 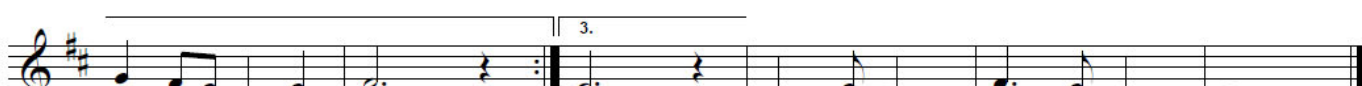
