**From the Music Department:**

The Choir: The choir must not minimize the musical participation of the faithful, but since it comprises persons who possess requisite musical skills and a commitment to an established rehearsal schedule, the choir can enrich the celebration by adding musical elements beyond the capabilities of the congregation alone. An important ministerial role of the choir is to sing various parts of the Mass in alternation with the congregation. At other times, the choir performs its ministry by singing alone, drawing on the treasury of sacred music from different composers, periods, styles, and cultures. When not exercising these particular roles, the choir’s role is not to lead congregational singing, but to sing with the congregation. Like all liturgical ministers, choir members should participate in the entire celebration, recognizing that they are servants of the Liturgy and members of the gathered assembly.

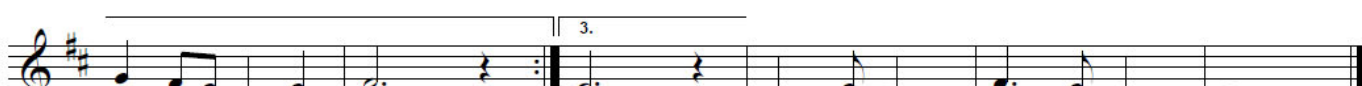
