**From The Music Department:**

The psalmist proclaims the Psalm and Gospel Acclamation and leads the gathered assembly in singing the refrain. Although this ministry is distinct from the role of the cantor, the two ministries are often entrusted to the same person. The cantor is both a singer and a leader of congregational song. Especially when no choir is present, the cantor may sing in alternation with the assembly, as in the invocations of the Kyrie, intoning the Gloria, leading the singing of the Agnus Dei, or singing verses of the psalm or song that accompanies the Entrance, Preparation of the Gifts, and Communion. In order to promote the singing of the liturgical assembly, the cantor's voice should not be heard above the congregation. At times it may be appropriate to use a modest gesture that invites participation and clearly indicates when the congregation is to begin; thus, cantors should lead the assembly from a place where they can be seen by all without drawing attention from the liturgical action. (*paragraphs 34-39*)

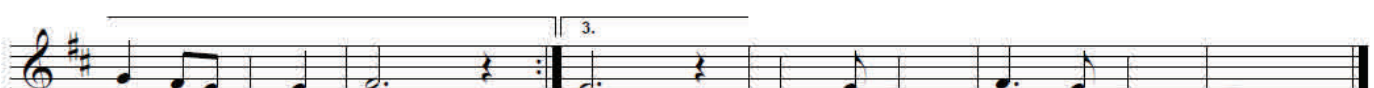
