From Sing to the Lord: Music in Divine Worship: The primary role of the organist and other instrumentalists is to lead and sustain singing, without dominating or overpowering, and to add varied and colorful dimensions to the song of the assembly. Those with the requisite talent and training should be encouraged to continue the tradition of improvisation; when worthy improvisation is not possible, it is recommended that musicians play quality published literature. There are also times when instruments may be played alone, such as preludes, postludes, and during the Preparation of the Gifts. A professional director of music ministries provides a major service by working with the bishop or pastor to oversee the planning, coordination, and ministries of the diocesan or parish liturgical music program. The director fosters the active participation of the liturgical assembly in singing, coordinates the preparation of music, and promotes the ministries of choirs, psalmists, cantors, and all who play instruments that serve the Liturgy. Directors are collaborators with bishops, priests, and deacons, which configures them to Christ the Head and consecrates them to a role that is unique and necessary for the communion of the Church. 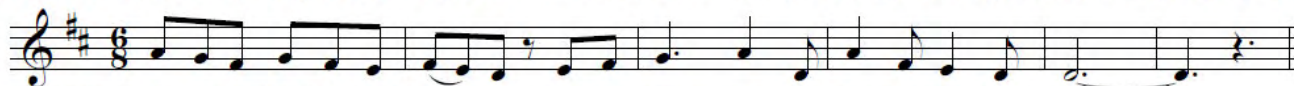

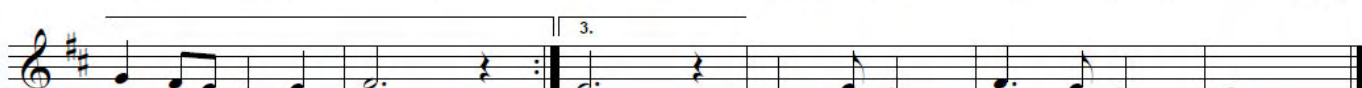
