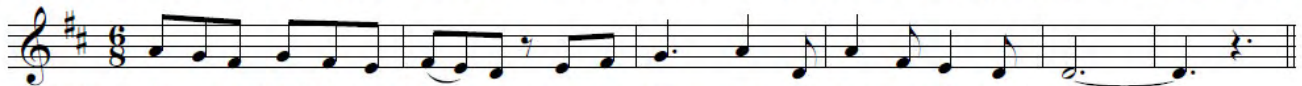

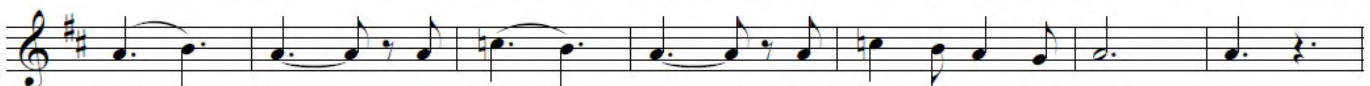
Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father,

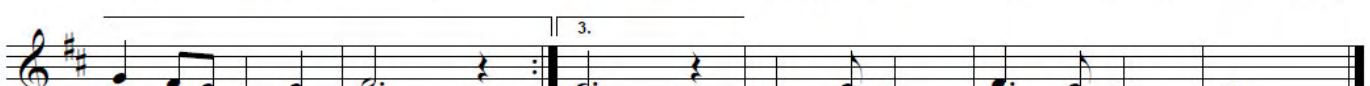
