All Saints Day: The Solemnity of All Saints is Tuesday, November 1 and is a Holy Day of Obligation. The Cathedral will have a Vigil Mass on Monday, October 31 at 5:30PM and on November 1 at 12:10 PM. Please be sure to mark your calendars. May All the Saints intercede for us!

All Souls Day: The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed is celebrated on Wednesday, November 2. Although, not a Holy Day of Obligation it is a wonderful day to participate in Mass and remember family and friends that have gone before us. The daily Mass at the Cathedral is at 12:10PM. Remember a Corporeal Work of Mercy is to bury the Dead(therefore to help someone or a family that may have difficulty in paying for a funeral of a loved one and the upkeep of places of burial). One of the Spiritual Works of Mercy is to pray for the dead through offering private prayers, having a Mass offered for someone who has died and going to cemetery and praying at the grave of someone.

Also, in the pews you will find All Souls envelopes, which you can write names of those you would like to be remembered during the month of November. Please turn in the envelope through the collection basket or drop off at the Cathedral Office. The names will be placed on the altar and be remembered throughout the month of November. There is a tradition of a small offering to be given, but in no way required!

You will pick the age and gender of the child, fill the shoe box with gift items and return the box to the parish office with \$9 for postage. A list of suggested items is available. 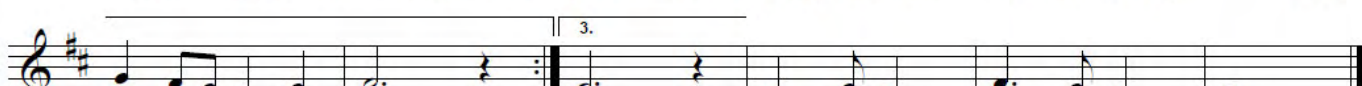
